Registration Fees are billed annually upon (re)enrollment and reserve a student's seat at Smith Preparatory Academy. Re-enrolling students are billed for registration on February 1. Registration fees are not refundable at any time for any reason. **After March 31st registration increases \$50. After June 1st registration increases \$100.**

Tuition covers the cost of books, (except for dual enrollment) curricular materials, classroom instruction, and other operational expenses at Smith Prep. In addition to tuition, families are required to purchase a school uniform as well as common school supplies, such as pens, pencils, and paper. Field Trips and extra curricular activities and events are not included with tuition and need to be paid separately.

Cottage Students may participate in Common Arts Fridays (see school calendar) for an additional fee.

Smith Prep annual tuition includes following services: record keeping, curriculum counseling, and standardized testing (required in grades 3-10). For high school students, tuition also includes: credit advising, diploma, graduation, transcripts, dual enrollment options, Florida Bright Futures and scholarship documentation.

Families may opt out of the services listed above and choose to participate in either Smith Prep program as a "Guest". These students must be registered with the county or another private school. SPA will not hold academic records, provide academic advisement, or provide the services listed above for students enrolled as "guest". There is no difference in tuition for those opting out.

All classes meet for 35 weeks in the academic year. Dual enrollment classes may meet for 18 weeks per semester.

Tuition payments begin on July 1. There are three payment options in FACTS: one-payment, two-payments, or ten-payments. Families may choose payment plan each year when completing (re)enrollment packet.

Credit evaluation for new students entering 10th, 11th, or 12th Grades: our Guidance Counselor will evaluate course work to verify that standards have been met and qualify for high school credit at SPA. The fee for this additional service is listed in the tuition chart.

Multiple Students in a Family: Full tuition is charged for the first student. Each additional student from the same family will receive a \$200 discount on tuition.

* **High School Seniors:** Senior Seminar Course is required for graduation. Base tuition includes 4 required courses that qualify for college credit and 1 elective. Additional book fees may apply.

* **Elective courses** may require additional books not included with tuition.
